

# Film Competition 2010

This summer Childnet will be launching a summer film challenge for young people aged 7-16. Launching on 4<sup>th</sup> May 2010, two separate projects are in place for primary and secondary aged children to create a positive message about the internet. Once you have registered, you will be emailed a lesson plan, further resources and most importantly, this year's theme!

All you have to do is to think about the theme, decide on how you are going to film your message and so long as you keep it to 60 seconds and get it back to us by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May 2010 you're in with a chance of winning!

## How does it work?

The shortlisted finalists will be selected from each category and invited to a private screening in London during the first week of July.

Our judging panel will then select a winner and two runners up from each category (judges will be revealed to invited finalists)

Competition opens: 9am on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> May

Competition closes: 5pm on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May

Finalists notified: 14<sup>th</sup> June

Screening & finalist event: First week of July (date to be confirmed)
