

Frequently Asked Questions

Storyboard Category



★ What is the Storyboard Category?

This category is open to all young people aged 7-18 who would prefer to draw their idea as a storyboard or might not have access to tech or filmmaking equipment. The storyboard should include a script and direction of what's happening. Have a look at the example on our website.

★ When do I have to get my storyboard back to Childnet?

The cut off for entrants is **17:00 GMT on Monday 22nd June 2020**. We will not be able to enter any film that arrives after this date.

★ When will I find out if I've won?

The winner will be announced on **Friday 3rd July 2020**.

★ How long should the storyboard be?

Your storyboard should be between 6 - 12 frames (or picture boxes) with script and direction underneath.

★ What should I use?

You could use the storyboard template in your competition pack or choose to use your own. Just be sure to keep it between 6 and 12 frames. You can use pens, pencils or even do it online.

★ How do I send you my storyboard?

Completed storyboards and forms must be sent electronically (e.g. Dropbox or WeTransfer) to film@childnet.com. **Remember the cut off is 5pm on Monday 22nd June 2020.**

REMEMBER: A parent, carer or teacher has to enter your storyboard on your behalf. It would be a good idea to ask them to oversee your work to make sure that you keep to the theme of the competition.

★ What about adding images from an online game?

It's your ideas and drawing we want to see! Try to avoid using images that have already been created.
